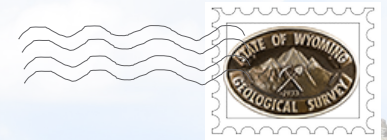


Next stop on the ABCs tour of Wyoming's geologic wonders ...

Clinker



- *Rock that has been baked by the burning of coal beds*
- *Contains material similar to bricks, ceramics & glass formed by intense heat*
- *Often red in color & more resistant than surrounding rock*
- *Found near Buffalo (where photos were taken) & in the Powder River Basin*
