Ervay Basin



- *In central Wyoming, south of U.S. Highway 26 between Shoshoni & Casper*
- *On the crest of a north-plunging faulted anticline that folds rocks from the Cambrian Flathead Sandstone through the Paleocene Fort Union Formation*
- *Raderville field produces oil on crest of anticline, mainly from sands in the Cody Shale Bentonite is now being mined from the Frontier Formation*
