Clinker



- · Roch that has been baked by the burning of coal beds
- · Contains material similar to bricks, ceramics & glass formed by intense heat
- · Often red in color & more resistant than surrounding rock
- · Found near Buffalo (where photos were taken) & in the Powder River Basin
