

- Photo taken 22 miles south of Rawlins in Carbon County
- Entire Aillside exposure of the formation & the Steele Shale
- Niobrara Formation here is very shaley but cliff-forming in the left side of the hill
- Oil production in the subsurface is nearby
- Fields that produce from the Niobrara Formation are red on map
