- A foreign inclusion in an igneous rock
- Represents pieces of older rock incorporated into the magma while it was still fluid
- Found in various areas of the state, such as (beginning below, clockwise) in a kimberlite south of Laramie, on Boars Tusk in southwest Wyoming, & in the central part of the state
