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FORMATION.

The formation for numerous examples of granite, which is
found in the vicinity of the Jupiter and New Harbor lines, the

Development on the other claims would consist of similar work in most favorable places but at present this should be confined to the No. 4 claim, as above.

It is recommended that steps be taken to patent these claims as soon as consistent, as their situation in this location is valuable and perfect title should be secured at once.

The group is covered with a fine growth of timber suitable for all purposes of mining and the work of development may be economically and conveniently done.

Supplies of all kind may be had as heretofore and delivered at the property at reasonable rates.

Underground work may be carried on here at all seasons of the year, but surface work must be done in summer time, owing to heavy snows usual in this altitude.

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LOCATION AND EXTENT.

The Jupiter Group of drift is situated in Section 8, T. 14N., R. 70 W. near the town of Hoback, Albany County, Wyoming, about 45 miles south-west of Laramie on the Union Pacific Railroad, in what is known as the Medicine Box Mountains in Southern Wyoming.
