Reese Iron

A small knob of weathered and decomposed granite. It seems that only the near surface material has been altered to hematite because much of the rock, on being broken open, has a considerable amount of admixed granite.

The knob is about 110 feet high at a maximum and about 100'x 100' in horizontal dimensions. It is a fairly round hill.
