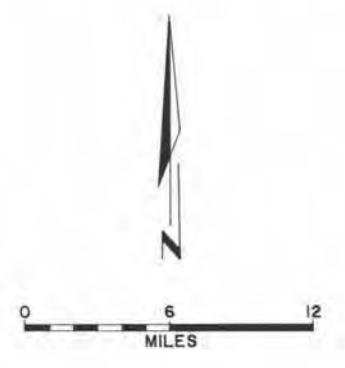


LEGEND
