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INTRODUCTION

This report revises and updates previous bibliographies compiled by Gary B. Glass in 1985, Sally L. Petersen in 1974, and Richard W. Monckton in 1970. New entries were obtained primarily from replies to a questionnaire sent to colleges and universities in the United States. Additional entries were obtained from Dissertation Abstracts International and University Microfilms International.

Colleges and universities are organized alphabetically by state and the entries for each university or college are listed chronologically, beginning with the earliest entry. The theses and dissertations listing is followed by an author index and a generalized subject index.
