Lost Mattock - T. 54, R. 87 W.

Trench about 45' long and increases from 0' to 15' in depth. The rock appears to be serpentine of some sort. It carries a small amount of galena - an occasional speck. Mr. Craig tested it for Ni, Ag, and Cu and finds all of them - no zinc. He is, however, no chemist.

Looks poor. Not enough of anything as far as I can see - should be assayed. N.G. for Pb. About 3000' SW of Mosaic Claim.
