Shipped 34 cars of about 48 tons per car since Dec. 1st.

Fairly large pit 40' x 50' in feldspar. More quartz than at the Beaver Claim and not as good quality. Have a nearly horizontal dike of granite a foot or so thick. Looks as though the material were better in depth.

A fairly large body from surface indications. Gets \$3 per ton - FOB the cars. Could get up to \$11.50 - \$17.00 ground to 20 mesh.

Feldspar.

Goes to Illinois Glass Co. to make Dura-glass for jars, etc. Some is used for paints and enamels.
